## **Brownstown Speedway Rookie of the Year Eligibility**

Drivers wishing to compete for Rookie of the Year in any division at Brownstown Speedway must notify track personnel of their intention before being considered eligible for Rookie of the Year. Drivers must give notification at the draw window prior to their second point's race of the year at the Speedway and will then be notified of their eligibility status. Drivers' eligibility status for Rookie of the Year will be determined by track Management and will follow the following guidelines:

- 1. To be considered a rookie in any division, a driver may not have previously participated in more than **5** prior career events in that division at Brownstown Speedway or a driver may not have previously participated in more than **12** prior career events in that division at any other track or sanction.
- 2. Drivers' may not drop down a division and still be considered a rookie. Drivers may only move up in division to be considered progression of order is as follows: Hornet, Pure Stock, Super Stock, Modified, Late Model (Super or Crate).
- 3. Drivers with limited experience (see Rule 1) in another division that is not a normal Brownstown Speedway division will be compared to a similar Brownstown Speedway division in determining eligibility.
- 4. Rookie of the Year for a division will be determined by the highest season point total accumulated in that division, using Brownstown Speedway's regular point standings procedures. To be eligible, a driver must run at least 50% of the points races for that division.
